

Judith Lynn Stillman

Judith Lynn Stillman, hailed by Wynton Marsalis as "a remarkable virtuoso, a consummate artist," is an internationally-renowned pianist, composer, filmmaker, choral conductor and music director. Stillman holds Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral degrees from The Juilliard School, winning Juilliard's Concerto Competition and Dethier Prize for Outstanding Pianist. Recipient of the Pell Award in the Arts, the Bannister Award for Civil Service in the Arts, and winner of 18 competitions, Stillman is the Artist-in-Residence and a Professor of Music at Rhode Island College. Highlight performances include Marlboro, Tanglewood and Grand Teton Festivals; guest artist with Borromeo, Shanghai, Lydian, and Cassatt Quartets; visiting artist in Russia, China and the Czech Republic; world premieres in Lincoln Center; duo-recording with Wynton Marsalis on Sony; Sony Wonder Museum exhibit with Mark O'Connor; Grammy's in honor of Rostropovich; BOSE commercial with Herbie Hancock. Stillman's films, for which she serves as director, composer and pianist, featuring Metropolitan Opera singers, premiered in Hollywood and garnered prizes in international film festivals, including Grand Jury Prize: Best Music Video, Best Multimedia Film and Best Music Score in LA, Montréal and NY. <http://judithlynnstillman.com/>
